

Intervention Guideline

Program:	Reading Eggs
Description:	Reading Eggs is a unique online world where children learn to read. It supports each child's learning by offering individual, one-on-one lessons that allow children to progress at their own rate.
Targeted Students:	Reading Eggs now has 120 big lessons. These 120 lessons are perfect for 3 to 7 year olds who are learning to read. Eggsplorers is another part of Reading Eggs World. This world is perfect for 6-8 year olds who already know the basics of reading but who still have much to learn about reading, writing, spelling and comprehension.
Format:	Schools must purchase an online account to begin using Reading Eggs. Once the account is set up, students will take a placement test determine their appropriate starting level. Students can access Reading Eggs from the classroom or at home. (Passwords can be shared with parents.)
Assessment/ Progress Monitoring:	Assessment is built into the program allowing students to progress at their appropriate level through the maps.
Communication of Student Progress:	Teachers can gain student progress through reports generated on the website
