

Intervention Guideline

Program:	Six Minute Solution Intermediate
Description:	Six-Minute Solution Intermediate is a research-based, highly effective instructional procedure for students in grades 3-6. This procedure builds reading fluency in only six minutes of the instructional day.
Targeted Students:	Six-Minute Solution Intermediate is designed for all students in grade 3-6 who need fluency practice. This may also be used in grades 3-8 as an intervention.
Format:	In a whole group and small group settings, students can be taught the partner fluency model. Individual students can also work with a teacher to choral read a passage, select a target goal, and have daily fluency practice. Students can also practice with parents at home and with older students at school.
Assessment/ Progress Monitoring:	Teachers determine if students need this intervention, based on DIBELS benchmark and progress monitoring scores. Teachers use designated assessment passages to determine reading instructional level. Once the instructional level is found, the student begins at that level. Student progress is recorded on the provided Fluency Graph.
